## **Getting There**

Coventry Building Society Arena is in the heart of the UK with excellent transport links to London, Birmingham and the Midlands. The venue is within two hour's drive of 75 per cent of the country. By rail, Coventry is 55 minutes from London and 20 minutes from Birmingham Airport, with easy access to the M6 and wider motorway network.

## By Road

Coventry Building Society Arena is easily accessible by car, railway and bus, conveniently situated off Junction 3 of the M6. To visit us by car, enter the postcode CV6 6AQ into your sat nav.

#### **Car Parking**

We have 2,000 on-site car park spaces. We recommend you park in **Carpark B** for the Conference. This will bring you into the Arena on the South side entrance, which is closer to the BMUS Conference.

## By Train

Coventry Arena Station is on the Learnington-Nuneaton line and only eight minutes from the main Coventry train station. There are multiple bus routes available from the retail park opposite the arena.

#### Registration
